2019 has been quite a year for the Women's Resource Center in Athens! Our leadership has been dedicated to raising awareness of the Center and the pregnancy and parenting needs of our community, and God has provided an increase in volunteers, monetary gifts, material gifts, and much more. We are so thankful to everyone who partners with the Center and look forward to a wonderful 2020!

During 2019, the Women's Resource Center served **168 clients**, hosted **427 educational courses**, and performed 74 **ultrasounds**; all of these numbers *doubled* from the previous year!

We have partnered with other organizations in the Athens/Limestone community and made 227 documented referrals to outside organizations such as the Family Resource Center, L.C.C.I., and Crisis Services of North Alabama, among others.

In 2019, the Center was able to extend Tuesday hours from 9:00 am until 5:00 pm, thanks to more client advocate volunteers. We have also added a third day for free ultrasound screenings with the addition of another volunteer nurse and nurse practioner with the required ultrasound training. Another answered prayer during 2019 was the addition of 4 male advocates to walk with fathers through educational courses and parenting/family related decisions. God is so good!

The Alabama Department of Public Health produces a yearly report of abortion procedures by Alabama residents. The latest report is from the year 2017, with 23% of Alabama abortions being performed in Huntsville. The life-saving mission of the Women's Resource Center in Athens is to assist women and their families as they face difficult life circumstances in the midst of pregnancy, and point them to God, the Giver of Life, as we encourage them to choose life for their unborn child and assist them through their pregnancy, birth, and into parenting.

Every gift you give, every hour you serve, and every prayer you lift up matters to our mission, and we are thankful for everything!

## **2019 Annual Fundraising Banquet**

Our 2019 Annual Fundraising Banquet was amazing! To everyone who contributed in some way to the success of our 2019 Fundraising Banquet, THANK YOU! What a blessing this has been, and God has continued to stretch our faith and grow the Women's Resource Center; we are looking forward to seeing what He has in store in the coming months!
